CONTEST GUIDELINES

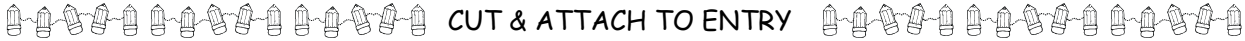
- Write based on yourself, your family or your family history.

- 750 word maximum.
- Entries can be handwritten or typed.
- Judging will be based on creativity and content.
- All entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- Entries must be postmarked by May 26th, 2006.
- Entries will not be returned.
- Only winners in each category will be notified by phone.



Entrants may see their work displayed and meet Karen Hesse at the *Thirteenth Biennial conference on Literature and Hawai'i's Children*, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, June 15th, 16th, 17th, 2006.
